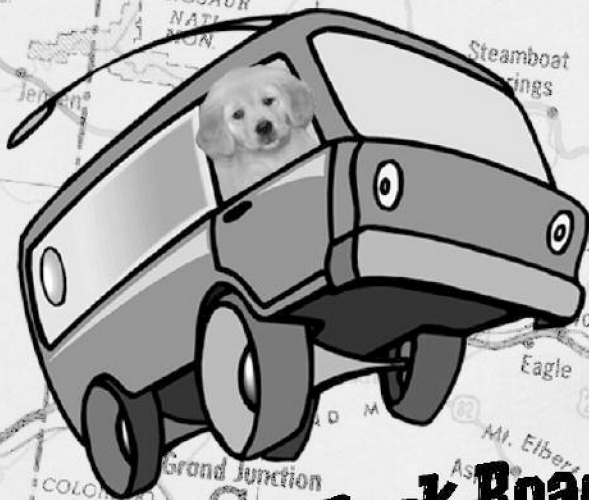

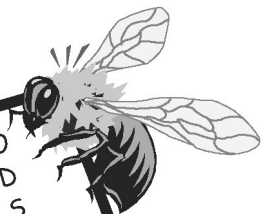

What is your favorite meal? Describe in detail all the ingredients.



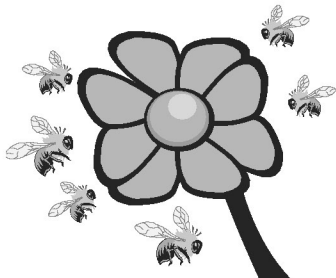

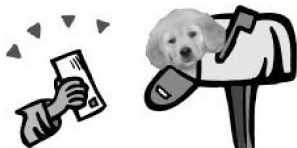
